A free webinar for Veteran advocates about Older Adult Protective Services

Over half of Pennsylvania's Veterans are age 60 and older. The Older Adult Protective Services Act (OAPSA) is designed to help Pennsylvanians age 60+ who are experiencing abuse, neglect or exploitation. All Veteran advocates should be familiar with how this program works and how it helps.

This free 60-minute webinar, presented by staff in the Protective Services Division at the PA Department of Aging, will educate you on the OAPSA law, how to recognize signs of abuse and exploitation, statistics specific to PA Veterans, how to make a report, and what to expect if/when you do report.
